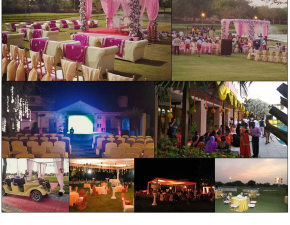


**WEDDINGS AT KENSVILLE**
